Description of Assessment Scores: Units of Inquiry for students in grades K-5 are reported using a grading scale of 1-4. The chart below indicates the level of performance associated with each number in the scale. Student academic performances are assessed using a variety of tools. Students will typically perform in the highest range of scores in the areas in which they are excelling and working well above grade level standard. Scores in the lower range indicate students may need additional support both at school and home.
