School Uniforms

Girls' standard uniform:

- White or green polo with school emblem for students in grades 6-8
- Green polo with school emblem for students in grades K-5
- Green, v-neck sweater with school emblem (optional item)
- Evergreen cardigan (optional item)
- Gray skort
- Gray jumper
- Gray shorts
- Gray pants
- Closed-toe shoes
- Athletic style shoes
- Green fleece with school emblem (*and/or*)
- Green coat with school emblem (*and/or*)
- Green vest with school emblem
- Girls may wear black, gray, or white leggings with skorts in cold weather

Boys' standard uniform:

- White or green polo with school emblem for students in grades 6-8
- Green polo with school emblem for students in grades K-5
- Green v-neck sweater with school emblem (optional item)
- Evergreen cardigan (optional item)
- Gray shorts
- Gray pants
- Closed-toe shoes
- Athletic style shoes
- Green fleece with school emblem (*and/or*)
- Green vest with school emblem (*and/or*)
- Green coat with school emblem

P.E. uniform:

- THS white, gray or green tee shirt
- Gray or green gym shorts or gray sweat pants
- Gray THS sweatshirt (hoodie or zip style)
- White socks
- Athletic shoes

Dress Code

- Gray THS sweatshirts may be worn only with the P.E. uniform.
- Students may wear the green THS fleece and/or coat in cold weather. No other sweatshirt-type jacket may be worn. If necessary, a rain jacket or down coat may be worn to and from school and at recesses. Jackets may not be worn inside the classrooms.
- Shirts should fit properly and not be baggy or stained.
- Pants and/or shorts should fit properly at the waist. Baggy pants or pants which show undergarments are not permitted. Skorts should fit properly.
- All undershirts must be white and must be tucked in.
- Hats must be THS hats.
- Earrings should be studs or very small hoops.

Grooming Standard

Hair for both boys and girls must be clean, neatly groomed and out of the eyes of the student. Streaks of hair colors that are not a student's natural color are not allowed. Hair adornments such as feathers, jewels etc. are not acceptable.

Nails should be clean and neat. Only clear nail polish is allowed for students K-5. Students in grades 6-8 may wear appropriate colored nail polish.

Jewelry should be modest and not create a distraction in the classroom. Earrings may be worn but should not create a distraction. No other body piercings are allowed.

Free Dress

Certain days are designated "free dress" days. On such days students must wear neat, clean clothing that is appropriate for The Healdsburg School campus. Torn jeans, baggy pants, short-shorts, tank tops, and bare midriffs do not meet school expectations. Party dresses, open-toed sandals, and non-rubber soled shoes are not suitable for students. Shirts must have sleeves.
